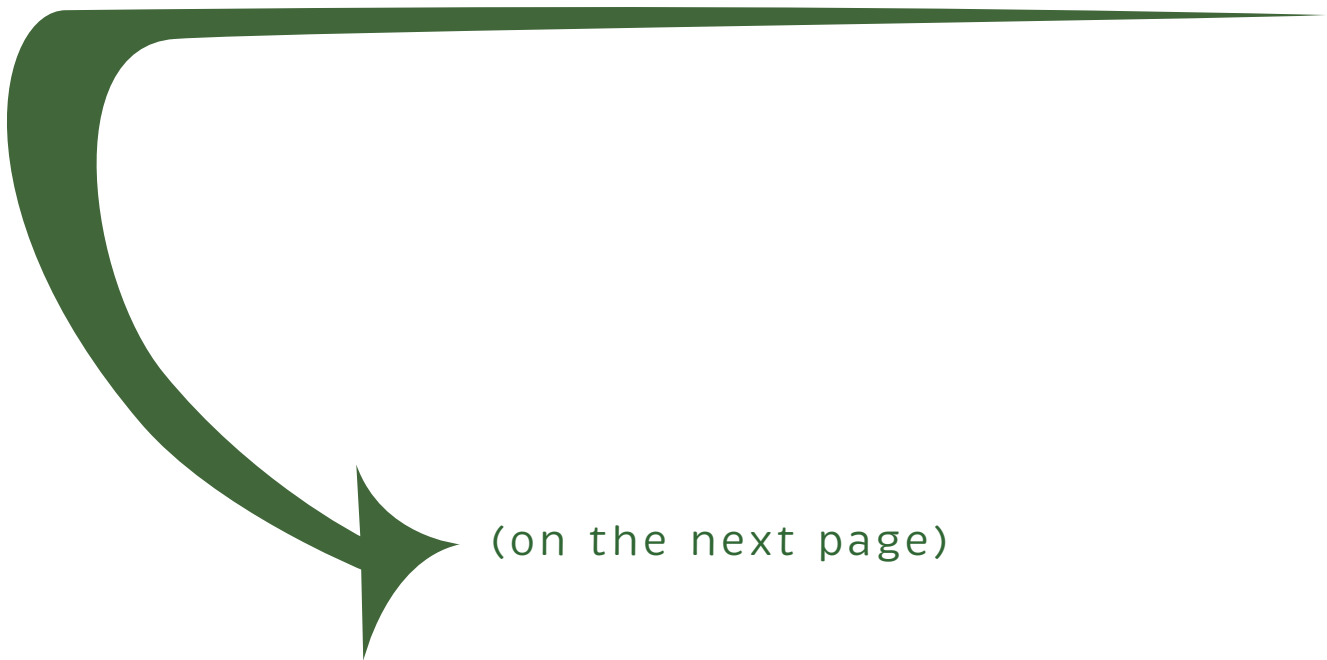

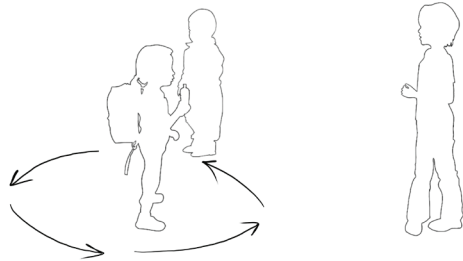


THE SKIES WITH SOLACE!

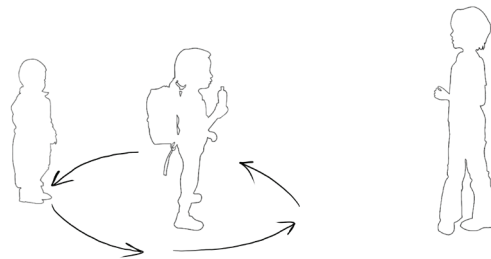
1. Here is what a new moon looks like, using our bodies. The moon is *between* the earth and the sun!



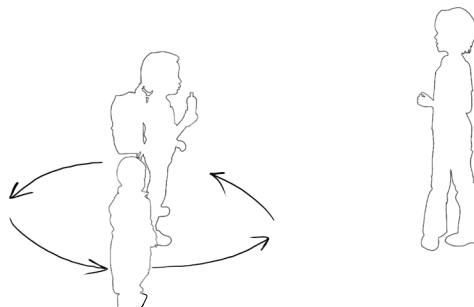
2. And then as the moon moves around the earth, the moon begins gaining light, which is called "waxing" and at this position is half full...



3. ...until they reach this position, on the opposite side of earth from the sun, when they are full and bright ...



4. ...and around they go to half moon again, this time losing light, which is called "waning", until they're back to New Moon again!
